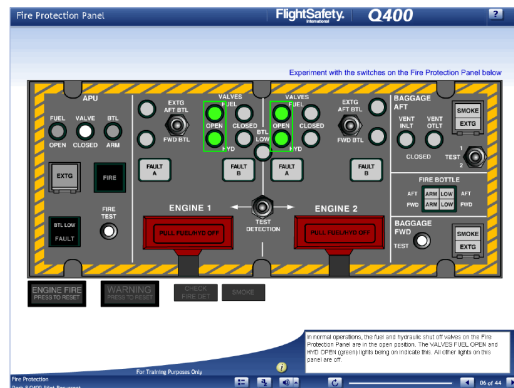


Description

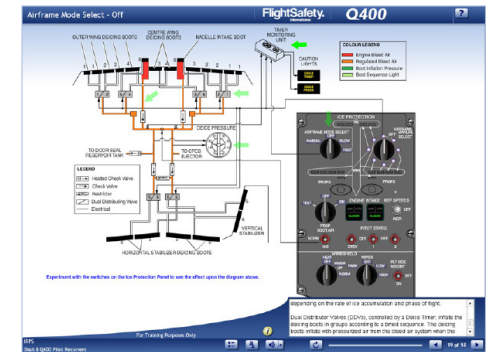

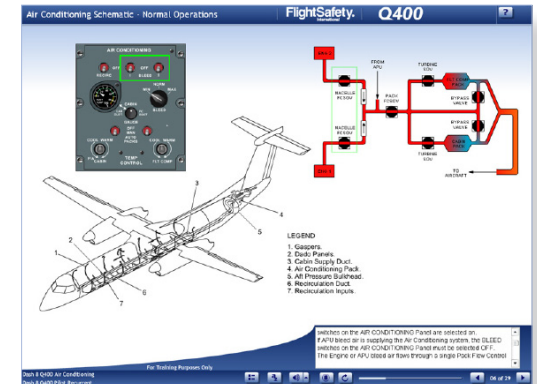
