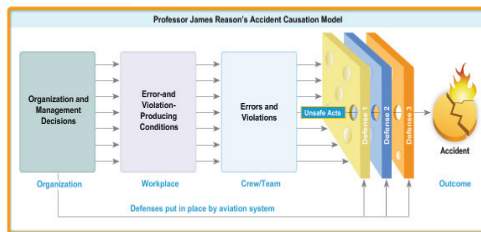


Positive Safety Culture

As aircraft systems and operating environments grow in complexity, the organizational, cultural and human aspects of our industry need to be addressed to ensure continuing improvement in aviation safety. That is the purpose behind your Safety Management System (SMS), as a proactive, organization-wide, evolving safety process. This five-hour course gives an in-depth introduction to the concepts and processes within Safety Management Systems and covers all aspects of hazard identification, risk management, accident/incident prevention and reporting. It is intended for flight department managers and those tasked with developing an SMS.
