Lesson Objectives Simulator - The simulator session reinforces material presented in the Helicopter Surviving Inadvertent IMC ground training segment. The client will be trained to understand the hazards and how to survive an inadvertent IMC event, and to respond to various instrument threats during a flight scenario. In addition, the crew will practice recovery procedures while implementing Human Factor and CRM techniques. All elements will be graded with a “T” for Training only.
